Summary of Actions

Approved the donations from:

- Foster Village Elementary PTA to Foster Village Elementary;
- Porter Elementary PTA to Porter Elementary;
- Robert Fennell to the Automotive Technology program;
- Bates Container to Birdville Elementary; and
- Chris Malvik to the Automotive Technology program.

Approved the cancellation of the 2014 BISD Board of Trustees Election. Joe Tolbert, Place 1, and Dolores Webb, Place 2, filed and are unopposed for the May 10 election.

Approved the audit firm of Hankins, Eastup, Deaton, Tonn & Seay to conduct the 2014 Fiscal Year End Audit.

Approved the waiver request to TEA for the missed instruction day on March 3 due to bad weather.

Approved the interlocal agreement with Purchasing Association of Cooperative Entities (PACE), and the resolution stating the district's intent to join and participate in the purchasing cooperative.

Approved the interlocal agreement with Tarrant County Cooperative Purchasing Program for the district to participate in the purchasing cooperative.

Approved the resolution authorizing the superintendent to excuse March 3, 2014 for all district employees. This was a result of the district's closure because of weather.
