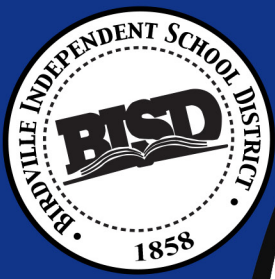
Sally Bustamante and Smurfit Kappa Bates were recognized for their valuable partnership with Cheney Elementary and BISD.
